Objective

More than 40% of all trauma deaths are due to haemorrhage. It is important that vascular surgeons are involved in the management of major trauma using their open vascular and endovascular skills to stop bleeding and repair vascular injuries. Vascular surgery is also one of the few multi-cavity specialties operating in the neck, chest, abdomen, pelvis, and limbs. This workshop covers vascular damage control techniques, imaging, management of specific vascular injuries, and case discussions. A day of practical training in vascular and endovascular trauma techniques is included.

The course is primarily designed for vascular surgeons or vascular surgeons in training with an interest for vascular trauma
